The Mitchell Trap Club will host the Fall State 4-H Shoot, September 7th and 8th in Mitchell, South Dakota. Youth qualify by participating in a qualification match in their home county, and then registering for the shoot by September 1st. Shotgun and Muzzleloading disciplines will participate.

Qualification scores required to participate are:

Shotgun—Beg 10/25, Jr 13/25 and Sr 15/25

Muzzleloading—Jr and Sr a score of 50 on the 50 yard Bullseye target

Directions to Trap Club:

The trap club is located just north of the Davison County Fairgrounds, on Havens/254th Ave.



FEES:

All Age Divisions have the \$10 per event fee (\$10 Trap, \$10 Sporting Clays, \$10 Skeet and \$10 Muzzleloading). Fees described below are range fees. These fees are paid as part of your fall shoot bill, but are charges from the trap club to the 4-H program. The \$10 fee is consistent with spring state shoot fees. Fee’s charged by the gun club, will include scorers during the tournament. The gun club will provide these, so the parents and coaches can watch their youth instead of doing those jobs.

Beginners may participate in Trap (50 targets) and sporting clays (25 targets). The registration fee for trap is \$22 (\$12 Trap Fee + \$10 Event Fee) and for sporting clays \$17 (\$7 Trap fee + 10 Event fee). If there is room, beginners may try skeet for fun. The cost will be \$24 (\$14 Trap Fee +\$10 Event Fee). Team rosters must be submitted by 9am Saturday! Team fees will be \$5/per discipline (Trap, Clay).

Juniors may participate in Trap (100 targets) and sporting clays (25 targets). Trap registration is \$ 34 (\$24 Trap Fees + \$10 Event Fee) and sporting clays \$17 (\$7 Trap Fee + \$10 Event Fee). There is no official skeet competition for juniors, but if there's room, they can shoot for fun. The cost will be \$24 (\$14 Trap Fee + \$10 Event Fee). Team rosters must be submitted by 9am Saturday! Team fees will be \$5/per discipline (Trap, Clay).

Seniors may compete in trap, sporting clays and skeet. Trap registration (100 targets) is \$34 (\$24 Trap Fee + \$10 Event Fee), sporting clays (50 targets) is \$24 (\$14 Trap Fee + \$10 Event Fee), and skeet (50 targets) is \$24 (\$14 Trap Fee + \$10 Event Fee). Team rosters must be submitted by 9am Saturday! Team fees will be \$5/per discipline (Trap, Skeet, Clay).

Seniors wishing to be considered for the national team must shoot all three (Trap, Sporting Clays and Skeet). Cost for a senior to try and qualify for National Team \$82 (\$34 Trap, \$24 Sporting Clay, \$24 Skeet)

Shotgun participants do not sign up for a specific time or day, just a registration placeholder to help the trap club with planning. **Competition will be open at 8:00 am on Saturday. Shooters must check in by 3 p.m. for all shotgun events if they wish to shoot competitively on Saturday. Competition will open at 8:00 am on Sunday. Clay and skeet shooters must check in by 10 am, and trap must be signed up by Noon in order to participate.** Flights are scheduled on a first come, first served basis.

Muzzleloading is open to junior and senior participants only. Registration is \$10 each. Team rosters must be submitted before any member of a squad fires! Team fees will be \$5. Target distance will be shot at 50 yards. The course of fire will be 10 shots on the bullseye target, 10 shots on the bottle novelty target and 10 shots on the animal novelty target. **Muzzleloading will have a relay on Saturday at 2 pm, and one on Sunday at 9 am.** More relays will be added if participation exceeds the firing points available.

How to register for Fall Shoot:

Registration for Muzzleloading and Trap will be done through the shooting sports website <http://sd4-hss.com/>. Trap and Muzzleloader teams will also use this website. You will not be registering for a specific time, you will be registering for a day (Saturday or Sunday).

Sporting Clay and Skeet teams must be submitted by 9am Saturday. If you are shooting later you will need to email your team roster to john.keimig@sdstate.edu, before Saturday.

Safety

Muzzleloading requires eye and ear protection be used throughout the competition. Jeans with holes are not acceptable. All holes need to be sealed. Sparks are common and skin protection is required.

Trap, Sporting Clay and Skeet require eye and ear protection to be used throughout the competition.

4-H shooting sport dress code will be followed. If you do not meet dress requirements you will be excused from the line to go change. Length of time to change will be at the discretion of the Range Officers.

Ribbons

Ribbons and awards according to the following:

Tie breaker for top 5 places in each age division in Trap:

1. Shoot off, of all available tied participants (with those not present placing after). Shoot Off will occur at the conclusion of events on Sunday (approximately 1:00 pm)

If/When, tied competitors are not available

2. Ties broken by longest streak.
3. If streaks are the same, ties broken by longest streak before a miss.
