



4-H Livestock Lease Qualifications

Livestock leasing for some animals is acceptable as a means for improving participant access. Eligibility guidelines for youth leasing animals include their not having adequate facilities to house the animal and financial means to own and take care of livestock.

Procedure

Though additional, private leasing contracts may be necessary in some situations, this form covers the South Dakota 4-H minimum standards and is required for those that lease. Exhibitors must upload this signed, completed Lease Form to 4HOnline by June 1. If leasing a purebred animal, the exhibitor must upload the registration paper to 4HOnline by July 1—the same animal owner name listed on this Lease Form should appear on the registration paper; therefore, the registration paper does not need to be in the exhibitor’s name.

Agreement

All signatories to this lease form agree that the following statements are true:

- This lease is eligible and appropriate under the Purpose guidance listed above.
- The leased animal is not and will not be co-leased, shared, or otherwise exhibited in competition by another 4-H, FFA, or similar youth member for the duration of the current 4-H lease agreement period.
