Exercise & Command	Signal Exercise Heeling pattern first, which ends with the commands: "stand your dog" "leave your dog" Signal the Handler for the following commands: Down Sit Come Finish Exercise Finished	Novice Heeling Pattern Novice heeling pattern comes before signals, ending with a turn or about turn. After the "leave your dog" command, handler is to walk straight ahead to the other side of the ring and face the dog. The signal exercise is to be done with the dog and handler approximately 35' apart. The handler may use ONLY signals throughout the entire exercise.	Scent Discrimination (4 articles - 2 metal, 2 leather) Are you ready?
