Pudding Slime

Ingredients:

- 1/4 cup instant pudding mix
- 1 cup corn starch
- 1/3 cup warm water

Instructions:

Step 1: Add instant pudding mix and half of your cornstarch to a mixing bowl. Add 1/3 cup of water and stir until slime begins to form.

Step 2: Slowly add the rest of your cornstarch, stirring as you go.

Step 3: When slime becomes difficult to stir with a spoon, finish mixing by hand.

Step 4: If the slime is still sticky, add more cornstarch. If the slime is too thick, add more liquid until you have the perfect texture.

Domino Challenges

Materials needed:

- Dominoes
- Craft sticks
- Ping pong balls

Challenge Ideas:

Rolling Reaction - make a domino chain that bumps a ball, which rolls down a ramp and knocks down more dominoes.

Build a Spiral - take curves to a new level.

Under the Bridge - use craft sticks and blocks to create a path that goes up, down, and under a bridge.

Would You Rather?

Start your meeting by asking the group various questions that make one part stand and another site.

Example comparisons:

Stand up if: you would rather have a pet snake. Sit down if: you would rather have a pet spider.

Fingertip Hula Hoop

Split your group into equal teams, have them stand together in a circle with their arms raised about their heads, and then pace a hula hoop on their fingertips. Using nothing but their fingertips, each team must work together to lower the hula hoop to the ground without dropping it. This is a great way to encourage your group to work as a team.
