



Commonly Available Pesticides for Trees and Shrubs - 2026

The chemicals (active ingredients) and their product trade names are those that are most commonly available in South Dakota and the inclusion of any trade name associated with a chemical shall not be taken as an endorsement nor the exclusion of any trade name as a criticism regarding effectiveness. Not all products listed for a chemical are equally effective for a specific pest. Refer to the label to determine whether a product can be used in a specific situation. Bold trade names are products used by commercial applicators. Read and follow all label instructions. The label is the final authority for a product's use on a pest or plant.

Key	Application Method
(FS)	Foliage sprayed.
(IN)	Injected into the lower trunk/root flare of the tree.
(SO)	Soil application either as soil drench or injection depending on label.
(TS)	Trunk spray, the height dependent on the insect to be managed.
(TS-B)	The lower 3-8 feet of the trunk sprayed, height on label instructions.
