



Introduction

This award recognizes a more comprehensive development of livestock/animal project knowledge in alignment with the 4-H Livestock Management Triangle* (see the end of this document). The results are published on the SDSU Extension website following the South Dakota State Fair.

Award Categories

There are nine specie categories and three age divisions for each specie (Beginner, Junior, Senior):

- Beef
- Dairy (dairy cattle and dairy goat)
- Dog
- Horse
- Meat Goat
- Poultry
- Rabbit
- Sheep
- Swine

Age Divisions

Age divisions for the South Dakota 4-H program:

- Beginner: Age 8, 9, or 10 as of Jan. 1 of the current 4-H program year
- Junior: Age 11, 12, or 13 as of Jan. 1 of the current 4-H program year
- Senior: Age 14, 15, 16, 17, or 18 as of Jan. 1 of the current 4-H program year

Scoring and Participation Details

- Youth must participate in all three areas - showmanship, Skill-A-Thon and a state level show - within the species to be eligible for the Premier Exhibitor Award for that species.
 - The following exhibitions will be used for showmanship and show scores:
 - » State Fair 4-H Shows for all livestock
 - » State 4-H Horse Show for horse
 - » Regional 4-H Dog Championship shows for dog
 - The following contests will be used for Skill-A-Thon scores:
 - » Clover Classic State 4-H Livestock Skill-A-Thon Contest for beef, goat, sheep and swine
 - » 4-H Dairy Skill-A-Thon Contest at the State Fair for dairy
 - » 4-H Poultry Skill-A-Thon Contest at the State Fair for poultry
 - » 4-H Rabbit Skill-A-Thon Contest at the State Fair for rabbit
 - » State 4-H Hippology Contest at the State 4-H Horse show for horse
 - » 4-H Dog Skill-A-Thon Contest at the Regional Dog Championship shows for dog
- If a youth shows multiple animals within the same species, the highest score prevails. Youth cannot gain more than 100 points per matrix column.
- Youth may compete in any species category in which they show.
- Tie-breaker order: showmanship > Skill-A-Thon > Market/Breeding > Coin Toss
 - Note: The tie-breaker order reflects our skill priorities. That is, we celebrate work ethic and care first, knowledge-gain second, and so forth.

Recognition

The top two individuals in each age division within each species will receive an award. Full results will be posted on the state fair page of the SDSU Extension website once the scores have been finalized. Youth may be recognized in person at either the South Dakota State Fair or another venue depending on the species. Youth receiving an award will be notified of the recognition plan for their species once results have been finalized.

Beef, Meat Goat, Sheep and Swine Premier Exhibitor Contests Scoring Matrix
